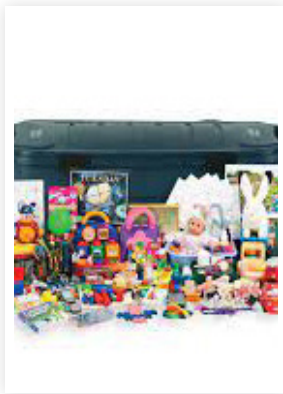

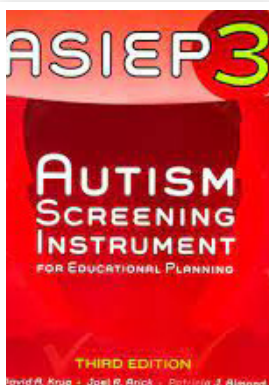

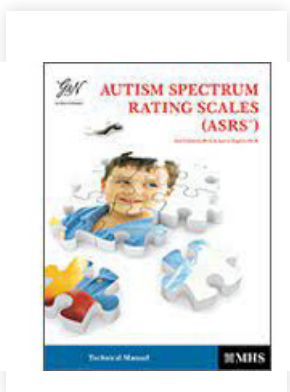
Autism Screening Instrument for Educational Planning (ASIEP-3)

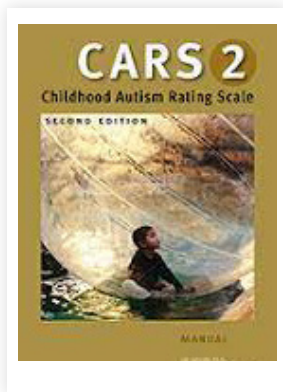

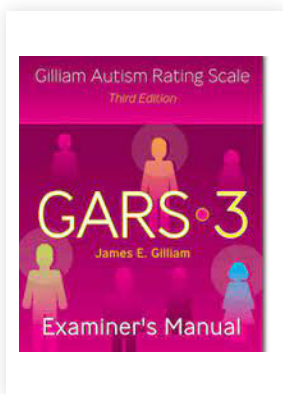
Helps to identify children with autism and determine symptom severity through quantifiable ratings based on direct observation.

Gilliam Autism Rating Scale, 3rd Edition (GARS-3)



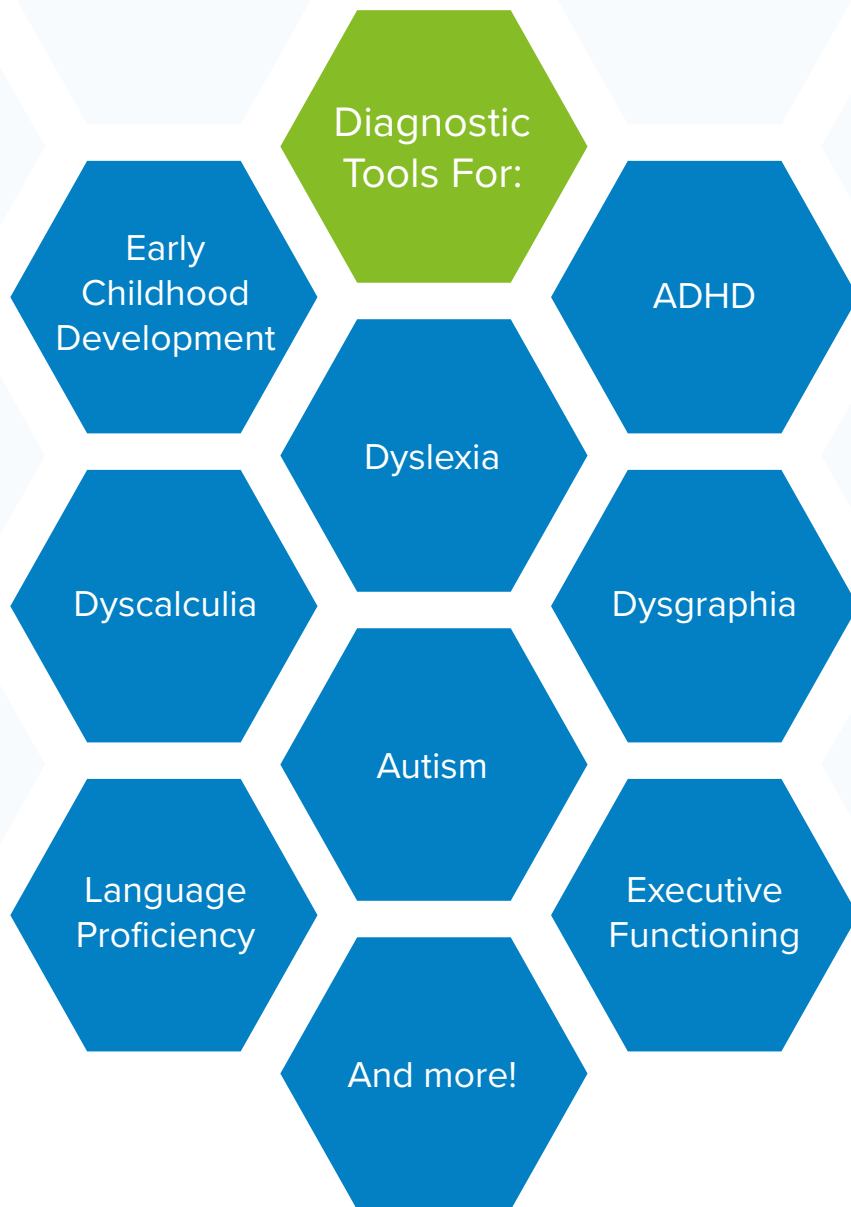
