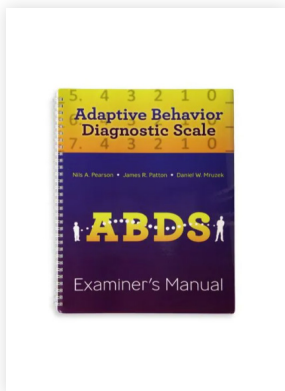

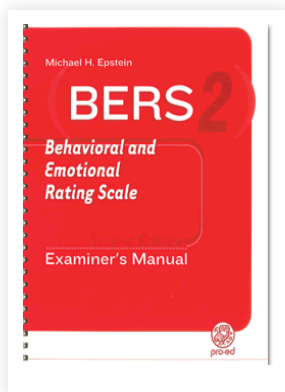

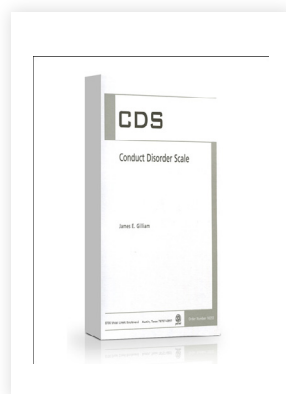

Conduct Disorder Scale (CDS)

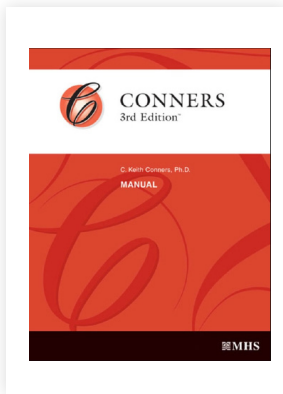

The Conduct Disorder Scale (CDS) is an efficient and effective instrument for evaluating students exhibiting severe behavior problems who may have Conduct Disorder. It is the only test of its kind that provides standard scores for use in identifying students with Conduct Disorder. The 40 items on the CDS describe the specific diagnostic behaviors characteristic of persons with Conduct Disorder. These items comprise four subscales representing the core symptom clusters necessary for the diagnosis of Conduct Disorder: Aggressive Conduct, Non-aggressive Conduct, Deceitfulness and Theft, and Rule Violations. The Draw a Person: Screening Procedure for Emotional Disturbance (DAP:SPED) is a screening test that helps identify children and adolescents who have emotional problems and require further evaluation. Appropriate for use with examinees ages 6 - 17, the assessment yields a standard score (T score) that determines if further assessment is indicated, is not indicated, or is strongly indicated.
